The Mobile Library has books for adults and children (fiction, nonfiction, Native American materials, mysteries, romances, science fiction & fantasy, westerns, Large Print) audiobooks, DVDs, & videos.

The HOPI DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, brings you the PUBLIC MOBILE LIBRARY (HOPI TUTUQAYKI SIKISVE) and makes various stops throughout the Hopi Reservation.

To COMMUNITY MEMBERS WITHOUT A LIBRARY CARD, a card may be obtained during your first visit to the new HOPI TUTUQAYKI SIKISVE (MOBILE LIBRARY).

1. The REQUIRED DOCUMENTS to obtain a Hopi Public Library Card are the following:
  - a. Photo Identification Card such as a Driver's License, State ID, OR student ID, AND
  - b. Proof of current address, i.e. recent utility bill, phone or cell bill, pay stub, etc.
2. References: the name and address of nearest relative not living with you.
3. Parents must sign the children's application card for their children to obtain a card.

To all PATRONS OF THE HOPI PUBLIC LIBRARY who still have your "OLD" HOPI PUBLIC LIBRARY CARD, please bring this card with you on your first visit to the new HOPI TUTUQAYKI SIKISVE (MOBILE LIBRARY). This "OLD" library card will still be valid after we update your Hopi Public Library Account. Your Hopi library card is valid in all public libraries in Navajo County. You only need one card.

THE TUTUQAYKI SIKISVE IS SCHEDULED TO STOP AT TWELVE LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT HOPI LAND, FROM KEAMS CANYON TO MOENCOPI. EACH BOOKMOBILE STOP WILL BE A BI-WEEKLY STOP.
